RESOLUTION NO. 039-2020

REQUESTING HON. WENDEL E. AVISADO, SECRETARY, DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT (DBM), TO GRANT/ALLOCATE FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN FRANCISCO, CEBU, THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY MILLION PESOS (P50,000,000.00) INTENDED FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF FARM TO MARKET ROAD FROM BARANGAY SOUTHERN POBLACION TO BARANGAY SAN ISIDRO, AND THIRTY FIVE MILLION PESOS (P35,000,000.00) INTENDED FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT/INSTALLATION OF LAMP POSTS SOLAR LIGHTS FOR THE ENTIRE CIRCUMFERENTIAL ROADS OF THE MUNICIPALITY

WHEREAS, the Municipality of San Francisco is in need of farm to market roads and solar street lightings and thus, prioritizes the establishments of the same;

WHEREAS, farm to market roads improve the mobility of people, goods, and services, motivate farmers to plant more, ultimately increasing their production, reduce transportation costs of farm input and output thereby increase local trade and minimize post-harvest losses thus, improves rural economy, and provide easy access to employment opportunities and basic social services such as schools and health centers,

WHEREAS, farm to market roads is one of the dimensions to food security, connect farms and coastal areas to main roads, hence promote agro-tourism;

WHEREAS, due to off-grid nature of solar street lights - this incur minimal operational costs, a delight for environmentalists around the world as it can provide significant lowering of carbon footprint of individuals, homes and businesses;

WHEREAS, solar street lights are wireless in nature and are independent of the utility company compared to conventional street lights, solar street lights require almost zero maintenance, and due to the absence of external wires, these lights do not pose any threat of accidents like electrocution, strangulation and overheating, and in fact, illuminate the streets throughout the night irrespective of power cuts and grid failures;

WHEREAS, considering that the above-mentioned priority projects of San Francisco needs millions of money in order to establish, it is being hoped and prayed that the National Government through the Honorable Secretary of the Department of Budget and Management, Atty., Wendel E. Avisado could allocate the needed amounts to realize these direly needed projects for the welfare of the people.

Now, therefore, on motion of Hon. Severino O. Gok-ong, Jr., duly seconded by Hon. Allen A. Arquillano and carried unanimously by the Members of the Sangguniang Bayan of San Francisco, Cebu presents and assembled,

RESOLVED, to **REQUEST Atty. Wendel E. Avisado, Acting Secretary, Department of Budget and Management (DBM),** to cause to allocate and to grant financial assistance of **Fifty Million Pesos (P50,000,000.00)** for the establishment of farm to market road from Barangay Southern Poblacion to Barangay San Isidro, and another Thirty Five Million Pesos (P35,000,000.00) for the establishment/installation of lamp posts solar lights for the entire circumferential roads of the municipality of San Francisco, Cebu.

FINALLY, to release a copy of this resolution to Atty. Wendel E. Avisado, Acting Secretary, Department of Budget and Management (DBM), Boncodin Hall, General Solano St., San Miguel, Manila for his information and favorable approval.
